3 SCENARIOS TO LOWER METHANE OUTPUT

When aiming for a more environmental friendly dairy farm, it makes sense to increase longevity of the dairy herd. This was shown by calculations from the Belgium research institute ILVO.



Dairy farming is an important contributor of methane gas into the environment. Methane gas (CH₄) is a much stronger greenhouse gas than CO₂ for example. Reducing methane output from agriculture is therefore high on the agenda. This can be accomplished by certain feeding strategies and feed additives. But also management is an important key factor to reduce methane output.

Older cows and earlier calving
 ILVO has been doing methane research for more than 10 years, using the so-called gas exchange chambers (GUKs). These chambers measure the emission of individual animals. ILVO also monitors methane emissions in groups of animals (lactating and dry cows) with specific measuring equipment (called GreenFeeds) in a research farm.

Different scenarios have been studied to lower the methane emission. A few of them are listed here.

1. Lower the age of first calving. Lowering the age at first calving from 26 to 24 months (on a farm with 80 young cattle per 100 dairy cows and a livestock population with a production of 27kg of milk per day). Showed a reduction of 3.1% of total methane emissions. If the calving age decreases from 28 to 22 months, under the same conditions, the total methane emission is even reduced by 8.8%.
2. Increase milk production. When a cow produces more milk, it also consumes more feed, hence leading to more methane output. However, because the efficiency of milk production improves, the total methane emission per kg of milk is decreased. Increasing milk production from 27 to 30 kg of milk per day, total methane emission per cow is increased by an average of 3%. But the emission per kg of milk decreases up to 4.4%.
3. Increase longevity. Older cows produce more milk which in turn can increase the efficiency and methane output per kg of milk (see point 2). It was calculated that if 5% less cows are being replaced by the farmer in combination with a production rise of 3kg per cow per day, a reduction in methane emissions of 11.7% per kg of milk can be seen.

Conclusion
 ILVO showed that there are various scenarios, besides nutrition and feed additives, that a farmer can work on to lower methane output of the dairy herd. Many of these management changes will also benefit the farmer financially.

COBB ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE CHINESE MARKET

Moves to supply Cobb genetics to far Eastern markets are in the pipeline following a decision by the New Zealand government to grant the company an Avian Transitional Facility certificate.



The move allows Cobb in New Zealand to import live poultry and poultry hatching eggs from approved countries and enable the firm to supply genetics to markets like China, Indonesia, Philippines and Thailand to help better meet the growing demand for chicken across Asia. Pelayo Casanovas, general manager of Cobb Asia-Pacific, said the certificate of approval meant that the company was one step closer towards beginning production in New Zealand.

Breeding stock delivery set to start June 2019
 Cobb has invested nearly \$50m in building the pure-line facility at Huntly, which is expected to create approximately 100 jobs in the area. And the approval of the ATF means that Cobb New Zealand is expected to begin the delivery of breeding stock in June 2019
 Barry Wards, specialist adviser for the New Zealand Ministry of Primary Industries (MPI), said Cobb's dedication to biosecurity was second to none.

CHINA: AI VACCINE WORKED BUT NEW VIRUSES IN DUCKS FOUND

Use of vaccine technology to control H7N9 avian influenza was generally successful in poultry but the research found new viruses in ducks, according to results published in Cell Host and Microbe. The Chinese vaccine was launched in September 2017 following the bird flu pandemic in 2013 and data has shown that vaccination of chickens successfully prevented the spread of the virus.

But it also led to the discovery of 2 previously undetected genetic variation of the H7N9 and H7N2 subtypes in unvaccinated ducks. Hualan Chen, a senior author on the paper and animal virologist at the Harbin Veterinary Research Institute, said: "It surprised me that the novel, highly pathogenic subtypes had been generated in and adapted so well to ducks, because the original highly pathogenic form of H7N9 has very limited capacity to replicate in ducks." Chen's team collected over 37,928 chickens and 15,956 duck genetic samples 8 months before and 5 months after the vaccine's introduction. They isolated 304 H7N9 viruses before the vaccine's release and only 17 H7N9 and one H7N2 virus after.

"Our data shows that vaccination of chickens successfully prevented the spread of the H7N9 virus in China. The fact that human infection has not been detected since February 2018 indicates that consumers of poultry have also been well protected from H7N9 protection."

SOYBEAN UPDATE FROM AROUND THE GLOBE

Escalating trade war issues between the world's 2 largest superpowers has prompted China to shun US soybeans.



Instead, there is clear evidence that China's soybean processors are snapping up record volumes of Brazilian cargo. China takes more than 60% of the commodity trade worldwide and the move away from buying the US crop has led to prices on the Chicago Board of Trade plunging to a 10 year low.

Record 12-14 million tonnes of Brazilian beans
 Brazil normally sends around 3.7 million tonnes to China in the 4th quarter, although last year the figure rose to 9 million. This year traders claim Chinese importers have booked a record 12-14 million tonnes of Brazilian beans for October-November arrival. Brazil could follow Argentina in exporting their expensive local beans to China and importing cheaper supplies from the US.

Soymeal supply/demand conundrum in India
 Meanwhile, a recent report from Rabobank has said India is facing a soy meal supply/demand conundrum. Increasing demand for poultry had led to higher consumption in recent years and that trend is expected to continue. The report said soy meal consumption stood at 5.4 million tonnes in 2017 compared to just 800,000 tonnes a decade earlier.

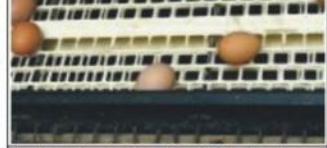
Consumption surpassing 9.5 million tonnes in 2025
 Rohit Dhandra, a grain and oilseeds analyst said he expected to see consumption growing annually at 7% which would lead to consumption surpassing 9.5 million tonnes in 2025. "The growth of the poultry industry has resulted in a proportionate rise in domestic soy meal consumption soy meal is a major source of feed protein for poultry. Apart from the possibility of blending soy meal with other oilseed meals, the fortification of compound poultry feed with amino acids to replace soy meal as a protein source is also an option but so far, this is an undeveloped market in India. Therefore, Rabobank expects India's poultry industry to remain largely dependent on soy meal as a protein source in the near future. Rising domestic demand of soy meal could help the domestic soybean price sustain levels that are attractive to farmers, which is expected to result in sustained acreage for Indian soybean farmers in the future. However, the large presence of marginal farmers and fragmented land will remain a hindrance in strategic investments at the farm level."

Import of GM-free soybeans
 One issue that the Indian government may need to intervene is over whether to import GM-free soybeans. It has so far been reluctant to do so but only 12% of global soybeans are non-GM in nature (including India's own domestic production) and it is scattered across the globe, according to trade publication World Grain.

GLOBAL EGG INDUSTRY ADOPTS FORMAL POSITION ON ANTIMICROBIAL RESISTANCE

Egg industry leaders have adopted a formal position on antimicrobial resistance at their recent Global Leadership Conference in Kyoto, Japan.



The International Egg Commission (IEC) endorsed a statement that says its members support and will promote the responsible use of all antimicrobials to allow for the long-term safe production of eggs, safeguarding the availability of eggs and egg products for the world's consumers. The statement says that the IEC:

- Accepts that antimicrobial resistance (AMR), whether in humans or in animals, is an issue of global concern;
 - Acknowledges that the egg layer industry is a limited user of antimicrobials but that this limited use does not obviate the need for coordinated action with other animal product and human medical representative bodies, through the One Health approach of the OIE, WHO and FAO.
 - Will encourage the egg layer industry to reduce the use of antimicrobials, especially those for which resistance could pose the greatest animal and human health global risk.
 - Believes that the health and welfare of the birds in the care of producers must remain paramount and that care may include the responsible use of the right antimicrobials.
- Knowledge on AMR**
 Its approach will be to make sure all producers are aware of the current knowledge on AMR and be able to access new knowledge as and when it becomes available. The IEC will endeavour to make knowledge on the subject as widely available as possible and stimulate governments and organisations to keep records on the use of antimicrobials. And it said it does not support the use of Highest Priority Critically Important Antimicrobials in animal agriculture.
- UK leads the way**
 The UK has been leading the way in recent years in reducing antimicrobials in the poultry and egg sectors. The laying hen sector has eliminated all use of highest priority CIAs in the past 2 years.

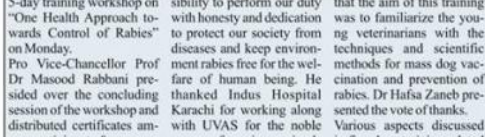
